- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Washington Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security correctional facility located in the Town of Fort Ann in Washington County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older.
Washington Correctional Facility has a special housing unit.
- II. **FUNCTIONS:** Washington Correctional Facility offers counseling services, volunteer services, academic education, vocational training, substance abuse treatment services, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), Alcohol and Substance Abuse Treatment (ASAT), community service work program, recreational activities, religious activities, industrial training, and transitional services.
Washington Correctional Facility is designated as an under 21 years-of-age facility, and inmates are offered an extensive range of education through the High School Equivalency Program, as well as Title I and Special Education Services Programs. It also offers college opportunities through correspondence courses and the Incarcerated Individuals Program.
Washington Correctional Facility is classified as Mental Health Service Level 3, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (29).
Washington Correctional Facility operates a DOCCS Regional HUB Recycling Center. This operation is capable of handling, processing, and marketing recyclables received from other DOCCS facilities as well as other agencies, and municipalities within the Great Meadow HUB.
- III. **CRITERIA:** To be eligible for placement in general confinement, an inmate must be designated medium security or less.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Washington Correctional Facility consist of dormitories for general confinement inmates and single cells in special housing.
